



MAF – Changes to alerts on CusMod for biosecurity clearance



The Ministry of Agriculture and Forestry (MAF) has reviewed the current tariff-based alerts for biosecurity clearance on CusMod. The purpose of the review is to validate and refine current alerts and to add any new alerts as needed.

MAF would like to minimise the number of non-biosecurity risk import transactions that are affected by these alerts. Some high level alerts have been modified therefore to exclude non-risk tariff codes.

The attached list sets out the changes to the MAF biosecurity alerts on CusMod. The changes will be effective from **12 October 2011**.
